



Dear Aurora resident,

We are pleased to share information about the upcoming Parker Road/Quincy Avenue/Smoky Hill Road Intersection Improvement Project, a long-anticipated effort to enhance safety, reduce congestion, and improve mobility for everyone traveling through this important corridor.

Construction is scheduled to begin in early February 2026 and is expected to continue through December 2026, with additional time built in to ensure the project is completed safely and successfully. During construction, travelers should expect periodic lane closures and traffic impacts on weekdays. Weekly updates, including specific traffic impacts, will be posted on the project website at [AuroraGov.org/POSH](https://AuroraGov.org/POSH). This project includes several key improvements designed to better serve the community, including:

- Adding and improving turn lanes at East Quincy Avenue and reconfiguring Smoky Hill Road to accommodate peak-hour traffic.
- Creating new and wider sidewalk connections along South Parker Road and East Quincy Avenue to improve access for people walking and bicycling, including those traveling to Cherry Creek State Park.
- Enhancing pedestrian crossings and relocating the crosswalk across South Parker Road to reduce conflicts with turning vehicles.
- Adding “Do Not Block” pavement markings near Atchison Way and Rice Place to help maintain access for nearby residents and businesses.
- Restricting left turns from Rice Place onto southbound Parker Road to address safety concerns.

Once complete, these improvements will help reduce congestion, improve traffic flow, and create a safer environment for pedestrians, bicyclists, and drivers alike.

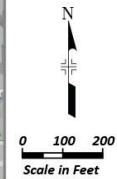
